Some Great Things from the last year

On top of the 300,000+ lbs of local produce, a few other exciting things...

The North County Harvest Hub

With funding from SLO County Integrated Waste Management, we established an equipment and vehicle storage hub in Atascadero for use by neighborhood harvest leaders in the North County!

Two Broads Cider collaboration glean and benefit cider

We had the honor of gleaning apples from the private orchard owned by Two Broads Ciderworks for use in producing a hard cider to benefit SLO Food Bank! Watch out for the cider release in Spring 2022!

Chamisal Vineyards donation garden

Early in 2021, Christian and Fintan at Chamisal Vineyards set out to grow an acre's worth of row crops, all to be donated to SLO Food Bank to benefit the community. We harvested these beautiful crops all throughout the summer, totalling 20,000 lbs in all!

The Autumn of 2021 marked our first ever Gleaner Hangout at Bang the Drum Brewery, where GleanSLO volunteers from across the program could connect and celebrate all we have done over the last 11 years!
